Remote Learning Information



The purpose of this leaflet is to support children and families to facilitate home learning during periods of school closures and self-isolation.

RELATIONSHIPS AND COMMUNICATION

During periods of school closure and self-isolation, maintaining relationships and **connecting** and **communicating** with others is very important. We want our children to continue to communicate with their teachers and peers in order to maintain a sense of belonging to Riverside Primary School. This regular communication and connection will take place on **SeeSaw** for P1-3s and **Google Classroom** for P4-7s. During school closures, all children will have the chance to participate in **Daily Check-ins** with their class and teacher using **Google Meet**.



Relationships with parents and carers are also very important and we will continue to communicate significant updates via our **school app**, **school website** and **twitter page**.

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REMOTE LEARNING

Remote learning tasks will be set on a daily or weekly basis by your child's class teacher. For P1-3 children, tasks will be posted on **SeeSaw** and for P4-7 children, tasks will be posted on **Google Classroom**. There will be **Literacy**, **Numeracy** and **Health and Wellbeing** tasks as well a range of other learning tasks from other curricular areas.



Remote learning tasks will be a mixture of new learning and consolidation of prior learning to make sure that children are still progressing and being challenged.

Teachers will specify when tasks should be handed in and how to hand them in. Children will be encouraged to share their tasks with their teachers so they can receive **quality feedback** and **next steps**.

Teachers can be contacted via email, SeeSaw or Google Classroom during school hours. If your child's teacher is on their reduced class contact time (RCCT), they will not be contactable, however you will be able to contact the RCCT teacher.

TOP TIPS FOR PARENTS/CARERS

Tips for supporting Home Learning

- Routines:



Create a routine to follow that fits around your family schedule and try to stick to it. It is best to have children complete tasks on a daily basis, rather than letting it build up towards the end of the week and overwhelming them.

- Realistic Expectations:



Remote learning may not replicate the work that is completed across a normal school week. So remember to focus on what is achievable for your child at home and prioritise tasks.

- Home School Environment:



You are not expected to replicate the classroom environment. However, children should have a quiet and comfortable space to complete their remote learning tasks.

- Parental Encouragement:



Try your best to encourage your child to check their SeeSaw and Google Classroom for updates. Encourage your child to work through their tasks without completing their tasks for them.

- Play, Breaks and Rest:



Make sure to incorporate time throughout the day for play and rest. This is very important for reducing screen time and promoting health and wellbeing. During breaks children should be encouraged to go outside for some fresh air.
