Dear Parent/Carer.

Welcome back! Hopefully you are all beginning to return to a more normalised way of life after a long break from school. It is great to see the children back and we are all excited about the session ahead. We are settling into our new class in Primary 5 very well and look forward to sharing it with you over the year.

This term our P.E sessions will be every Monday and Tuesday. In line with the current guidelines, we are not requiring a change of P.E kit, but children may come dressed in appropriate P.E wear if they wish. We will be outside for PE as much as possible, therefore a clothing/outerwear suitable for outdoor P.E is necessary to ensure we are safe and warm. Please try to send a filled water bottle to school with your child daily - as we actively encourage drinking water in class to help keep us fully hydrated, helping thinking. This also sets a very good example for others in school.

Parental support is greatly appreciated at all times but is particularly valuable during home learning sessions and it would be very helpful if home learning could be checked over. Home learning will go out on a Friday and should be returned the following Tuesday. Please note that we will be operating Google classroom after the October break and this will support home learning and communication.

Mr MacKay will be teaching P5M every Friday morning.
